Considered submissions (in English) will describe new ideas that celebrate all aspects of arts and cultural programming, planning, and development in local communities by members and non-members across Canada.

Approaches to P2P Sessions

- Presenter – topic presented with lots of time for Q&A
- Roundtable – topic presented with facilitated participant exchange
- Workshop – topic presented with hands-on or interactive component

Streams for P2P Sessions

Stream #1: Reaching Your Community
 Proposed topics could include: Local arts and culture success stories, community placemaking, truth and reconciliation, reaching diverse and underserved communities, public art and civic responsibility/accountability/engagement...

Stream #2: Cultural Economy

Proposed topics could include: Entrepreneurship and innovation, creative hubs and incubators, developing the film and music sectors, night-time economy, cultural districts, public art and festivals and events...

Stream # 3: Planning for a New World

Proposed topics could include: Ensuring safety and security in festival and event planning, inclusive places and spaces, reconsidering public art commemoration in contemporary times...

Stream #4: Sustainability & Cultural Planning

Proposed topics could include: New models for developing cultural infrastructure and creative spaces, affordable housing and spaces for artists and cultural workers, new trends in public art policy and commissioning, public art maintenance and collections management...

Further Details

- P2P sessions are between 45 and 60 min. including the Q&A (the session length will be confirmed with the successful presenter)
- Submissions will be reviewed by the 2018 Summit Planning Committee on meeting the eligibility criteria, and relevance to the Summit's theme. Consideration will be given to ensure diversity in content, geography, and community size
- Presenters will be profiled on the CCNC website and in the Summit program

- Presenters receive a discounted rate of \$550 to attend the Summit
- Presenters must register by **August 19, 2018**.
